## **Resolution No. 2019 - 140:**

APPROVAL AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE 2020 CDBG APPLICATION/PROPOSAL AS SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNING BODY TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM COMMITTEE.

Whereas, the Borough of Union Beach is desirous of participating in the FY2020 Community Development Block Grant program; and

Whereas, the Borough of Union Beach's Governing Body under the Community Development Block Grant Program has made recommendation to the Governing Body that an application be submitted for the project:

"Reconstruction of 9<sup>th</sup> Street from Florence Avenue to Pine Street" and:

Whereas, the total reconstruction of 9th Street which runs from Florence to Pines Street, and is in dire need of repair, with poor drainage and poor condition of the street pavement. We will maintain a 28 foot wide roadway with new concrete curb and sidewalks on both sides of the roadway and a total reconstruction of the roadway surface. In addition, we propose a new subsurface drainage system to collect roadway runoff. The roadway will be re-profiled to promote gutter flow to the subsurface drainage system.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Union Beach that the Governing Body does hereby Accept and Approve said project, as submitted for the project "Reconstruction of 9<sup>th</sup> Street from Florence Avenue to Pine Street"; and

Be it further resolved, that the Borough Engineer, Edward G. Broberg, P.E. of T&M Associates, Middletown, New Jersey is hereby authorized to solicit funding from the County of Monmouth, Community Development Block Grant Program for this project.
