WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Union Beach requested from the State of New Jersey, Civil Service Commission a new list of persons eligible to be appointed to the position of Police Officer (Certification No. OL200617) expiring January 21, 2021 in the Union Beach Police Department, and,

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Civil Service Commission conducted a test and provided the names those persons who achieved a passing grade on said test and listed the candidates in the order of their scores, and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Union Beach directed that the Police Applicant Investigation Unit conduct interviews in which the candidates provided written application, verbal responses to additional questions regarding police procedures, personal qualifications, additional information and,

WHEREAS, the Police Applicant Investigation Unit interviewed each candidate, and after factoring in the score on the Civil Service Commission test ranked the candidates they determined to be the best qualified. The Chief of Police, Michael J.
