<u>Environmental</u>: The Bayshore Regional Watershed Council and Save Coastal Wildlife have resumed their Thursday evening meetings as of November 12th at 7:30 pm. Activities have included seal monitoring and also training sessions for microplastic research training. Microplastics are big now because with people staying home they are finding a lot more plastics being discarded in the ocean and of course washing up on the shores. Resolution Authorizing Addendum Number 12 to AIA Document B101-2087 Standard Form of Agreement Between Owner and Architect

This addendum to AIA Document B101-2007 Standard Form of Agreement Between Owner and Architect ("Addendum") is entered into this 23rd day of November, 2020 by and between the Borough of Union Beach ("Owner"), with offices located at 650 Poole Avenue, Union Beach, New Jersey 07735, and The Goldstein Partnership (Architect"), with offices located at 515 Valley Street, Suite 110, Maplewood, New Jersey 07040.

WHEREAS, the Owner and Architect entered into an AIA Document B101-2007 Standard Form of Agreement Between Owner and Architect ("Agreement") for the Architect to provide professional services in connection with the Renovations & Addition to the Union Beach Municipal Building project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement contemplates that additional and/or extended services might be required of the Architect; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the Project Contractors' delays and failures; the Architect has provided extended services beyond those required by the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Owner agrees that the extended services are required due to the fault of the Contractors; and

WHEREAS, the Architect will submit an invoice in the amount of \$4,717.00 for its extended services relative to ongoing litigation with the original General Contractor through October 29, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Owner reviewed the invoice and determined that the time spent is reasonable and the amounts invoiced are consistent with the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, conditions and agreements contained herein and in the Agreement, the Owner and Architect desire to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The Architect's fees for the Project shall be increased in the amount of \$4,717.00 which amount shall be invoiced in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
- 3. The Contract Sum for the construction of the project as set forth in the Owner/Prior Contractor Agreement shall be reduced in the amount of \$4,717.00. The Architect shall prepare the necessary documents to reduce the Contract Sum and/or back charge the Contractor and/or include in claim against the Surety the fees for the Architect's extended services.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect and shall apply to the services set forth in the Proposal.

WHEREAS, The County of Monmouth, as the project lead, is interested in applying for a LEAP program grant to develop and/or procure a Community Rating System (CRS) management software for use by the County's municipal partners that participate in the National Flood Insurance Program's (NFIP) CRS program; and

WHEREAS, The CRS program provides discounts to flood insurance policy holders in our community located in special flood hazard areas, improves our resiliency to future flooding, and protects the health, safety, and welfare of our residents; and

WHEREAS, The County would like to offer a CRS management software as a shared service to municipalities to streamline the extensive CRS documentation and administrative process that many CRS communities find burdensome, costly, time consuming, and sometimes prohibitive to their full participation in the CRS program; and

WHEREAS, The County seeks to provide this type of software as a shared services pilot program, free of charge to municipalities for the first year and at a discounted rate in subsequent years; and

WHEREAS, Municipalities interested in partnering with the County on this LEAP Challenge Grant proposal must submit a conforming resolution to the County that memorializes the municipality's commitment to completion of the proposed project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Borough of Union Beach shall be recognized as a joint applicant with Monmouth County for the purposes of submitting a LEAP Challenge Grant for the procurement and/or development of a Community Rating System (CRS) management software in establishing a new shared service pilot program that will benefit our community.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$235,000, OR SUCH OTHER AMOUNT CERTIFIED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES, FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(L) AND/OR N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(M), IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Borough of Union Beach, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Borough") hereby appropriates an aggregate amount of \$235,000 to provide for (i) the immediate preparation, response, recovery, and restoration of public services during such time as a public health emergency, pursuant to the "Emergency Health Powers Act," P.L.2005, c.222 (C.26:13-1 et seq.), declared in response to COVID-19 remains in effect, in the amount of \$0, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(l) and (ii) a deficit in operations experienced by the Borough during fiscal year 2020, in which a public health emergency pursuant to the "Emergency Health Powers Act," P.L.2005, c.222 (C.26:13-1 et seq.), or a state of emergency, pursuant to P.L.1942, c.251 (C.App.A:9-33 et seq.), or both, has been declared by the Governor in response to COVID 19, in the amount of \$235,000, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(m). The appropriation authorized hereby shall be in the individual and aggregate amounts set forth herein or such other amounts as certified by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey (the "Director").

Section 2. The Borough shall apply for any financial assistance that may be available to the Borough from the federal government, the State of New Jersey, and other sources to offset any operating deficit directly attributable to COVID-19, and any such financial assistance obtained by the Borough shall be utilized to offset any operating deficit.

Section 3. A copy of this ordinance as finally adopted shall be filed with the Director.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon the latter of (i) the date determined by applicable law or (ii) the earlier of (a) the date the Director approves in writing the application submitted by the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough for approval of the special emergency authorized hereby (the "Application") and (b) the date that is 45 days (or the first business day following such 45th day, if applicable) following the date the Chief Financial Officer submits the Application to the Director.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL EMERGENCY NOTES IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION MADE FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(L) AND/OR N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(M), IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. An ordinance authorizing a special emergency appropriation of \$235,000, or such other amount certified by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services (the "Authorized Amount"), by the Borough of Union Beach, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Borough") for the purposes set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(I) and/or N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(m) has been finally adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough, and a copy thereof has been filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey (the "Director").

Section 2. (a) In order to finance the special emergency appropriation described in Section 1 of this resolution, the Borough is hereby authorized to borrow the Authorized Amount and to issue its special emergency notes (the "Notes") therefor in accordance with the Local Budget Law of New Jersey (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55) (the "Local Budget Law").

- (b) The Notes authorized by this resolution may be issued in amounts and denominations not exceeding in the aggregate the amount of Notes authorized herein, as determined by the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough pursuant to this resolution.
- (c) The Borough may finance the special emergency appropriation from surplus funds available or may borrow money in a manner prescribed herein. Where an appropriation is financed from surplus funds available, at least one-fifth of the amount thereof shall be included in each annual budget until the appropriation has been fully provided for, beginning in the year after the year in which the resulting deferred charge appears in the Borough's unaudited financial statement.

Section 3. The following matters in connection with the Notes are hereby determined:

- (a) All Notes issued hereunder and any renewals thereof shall mature at such time as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer within the limitations of the Local Budget Law, provided however, that at least one-fifth of all such Notes and the renewals thereof shall mature and be paid in each year, beginning in the year after the year in which the resulting deferred charge appears in the Borough's unaudited financial statement, so that all Notes and renewals shall have matured and have been paid not later than the last day of the sixth year following the date of this resolution;
- (b) All Notes issued hereunder shall bear interest at such rate or rates as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer;
- (c) The Notes shall be in the form determined by the Chief Financial Officer and the Chief Financial Officer's signature upon the Notes shall be conclusive as to such determination;

- (d) The Borough shall apply for any financial assistance that may be available to the Borough from the federal government, the State of New Jersey, and other sources to offset any operating deficit directly attributable to COVID-19, and any such financial assistance obtained by the Borough shall be utilized to offset any operating deficit or, if applicable, to payment of the Notes issued hereunder. The amount of Notes authorized but not issued hereunder shall be reduced to the extent that such funds are so used.
- **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized and directed to determine all matters in connection with the Notes not determined by this or a subsequent resolution and the Chief Financial Officer's signature upon the Notes shall be conclusive as to such determination.
- **Section 5.** The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell the Notes from time to time at public or private sale in such amounts as such officer may determine at not less than par and to deliver the same from time to time to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof and payment therefor.
- **Section 6.** Any instrument issued pursuant to this resolution shall be a general obligation of the Borough. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the Notes and, unless otherwise paid or payment provided for, an amount sufficient for such payment shall be inserted in the budget and a tax sufficient to provide for the payment thereof shall be levied and collected.
- **Section 7.** The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to report in writing to this governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the Notes pursuant to this resolution is made, such report to include the amount, description, interest rate and maturity of the Notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.
- **Section 8.** The Borough hereby makes the following covenants and declarations with respect to Notes to be issued by the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough on a tax-exempt basis, if any. The Borough hereby covenants that it will comply with any conditions subsequent imposed by the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), in order to preserve the exemption from taxation of interest on the Notes, including, if necessary, the requirement to rebate all net investment earnings on the gross proceeds above the yield on the Notes. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the Borough to deem the obligations authorized herein as bank qualified for the purposes of Section 265 of the Code, when appropriate. The Borough hereby declares the intent of the Borough to issue Notes in the amount authorized in Section 1 of this resolution and to use the proceeds to pay or reimburse expenditures for the costs of the purpose described herein. This Section 8 is a declaration of intent within the meaning and for purposes of Treasury Regulations §1.150-2 or any successor provisions of federal income tax law.
- **Section 9.** Solely for purposes of complying with Rule 15c2-12 of the Securities and Exchange Commission, as amended and interpreted from time to time (the "Rule"), and provided that the Notes are not exempt from the Rule and provided that the Notes are not exempt from the following requirements in accordance with paragraph (d) of the Rule, for so long as the Notes remain outstanding (unless the Notes and any renewals thereof have been wholly defeased), the Borough shall provide for the benefit of the holders of the Notes and the beneficial owners thereof:
- (a) Not more than 270 days following the close of the fiscal year in which the Notes are issued, electronically to the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board's Electronic Municipal Market Access ("EMMA") system or such other repository designated by the Securities and Exchange Commission to be an authorized repository for filing secondary market disclosure information, if any, annual financial information with respect to the Borough consisting of the audited financial statements (or unaudited financial statements if audited financial statements are not then available, which audited financial statements will be delivered when and if available) of the Borough and certain financial information and operating data consisting of (1) Borough indebtedness and overlapping indebtedness including a schedule of outstanding debt issued by the Borough; (2) property valuation information; and (3) tax rate, levy and collection data. The audited financial statements will be prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles as modified by governmental accounting standards as may be required by New Jersey law.
- (b) If any of the following events occur regarding the Notes, a timely notice not in excess of ten business days after the occurrence of the event sent to EMMA:
 - (1) Principal and interest payment delinquencies;
 - (2) Non-payment related defaults, if material;
 - (3) Unscheduled draws on debt service reserves reflecting financial difficulties;
 - (4) Unscheduled draws on credit enhancements reflecting financial difficulties;
 - (5) Substitution of credit or liquidity providers or their failure to perform;
 - (6) Adverse tax opinions, the issuance by the Internal Revenue Service of proposed or final determinations of taxability, Notices of Proposed Issue (IRS Form 5701-TEB) or other material notices or determinations with respect to the tax status of the Notes, or other material events affecting the tax status of the Notes;
 - (7) Modifications to the rights of holders of the Notes, if material;
 - (8) Bond calls, if material, and tender offers;

- (9) Defeasances;
- (10) Release, substitution or sale of property securing repayment of the Notes, if material;
- (11) Rating changes;
- (12) Bankruptcy, insolvency, receivership or similar event of the Borough;
- (13) The consummation of a merger, consolidation or acquisition involving the Town or the sale of all or substantially all of the assets of the Town, other than in the ordinary course of business, the entry into a definitive agreement to undertake such an action or the termination of a definitive agreement relating to any such actions, other than pursuant to its terms, if material;
- (14) Appointment of a successor or additional trustee or the change of name of a trustee, if material;
- (15) Incurrence of a Financial Obligation of the Borough, if material, or agreement to covenants, events of default, remedies, priority rights or other similar terms of a Financial Obligation, any of which affect holders of the Notes, if material; and
- (16) Default, event of acceleration, termination event, modification of terms or other similar events under a Financial Obligation of the Borough, if any such event reflects financial difficulties.

The term "Financial Obligation" as used in subparagraphs (b)(15) and (b)(16) above means a (i) debt obligation, (ii) derivative instrument entered into in connection with, or pledged as security or a source of payment for, an existing or planned debt obligation or (iii) guarantee of (i) or (ii); provided, however, that the term "Financial Obligation" shall not include municipal securities as to which a final official statement has been provided to the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board consistent with the Rule.

- (c) Notice of failure of the Borough to provide required annual financial information on or before the date specified in this resolution shall be sent in a timely manner to EMMA.
- (d) If all or any part of the Rule ceases to be in effect for any reason, then the information required to be provided under this resolution, insofar as the provision of the Rule no longer in effect required the provision of such information, shall no longer be required to be provided.
- (e) The Chief Financial Officer shall determine, in consultation with Bond Counsel, the application of the Rule or the exemption from the Rule for each issue of Notes prior to their offering. Such Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to enter into written contracts or undertaking to implement this resolution and is further authorized to amend such contracts or undertakings as needed to comply with the Rule or upon the advice of Bond Counsel.
- (f) In the event that the Borough fails to comply with this resolution or the written contract or undertaking, the Borough shall not be liable for monetary damages, remedy of the holders or beneficial owners of the notes being hereby specifically limited to specific performance of the covenants contained in this resolution or the written contract or undertaking.
 - **Section 10.** A copy of this resolution as adopted shall be filed with the Director.

Section 11. This resolution shall take effect upon the latter of (i) the date determined by applicable law or (ii) the earlier of (a) the date the Director approves in writing the application submitted by the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough for the approval of the special emergency being financed by the Notes (the "Application") and (b) the date that is 45 days (or the first business day following such 45th day, if applicable) following the date the Chief Financial Officer submits the Application to the Director.
