ORDINANCES: Meeting of December 15, 2022 ORDINANCE 2022-320:

The Clerk presented affidavit of publication showing that the ordinance was duly advertised in accordance with law in the Asbury Park Press in the issue of December 1, 2022.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-320:

MEETING OF DECEMBER 15, 2022

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PERMITTING PROCESS FOR CLOSURE OF MUNICIPAL ROADWAYS FOR SPECIAL EVENTS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Union Beach (the "Borough") periodically receives requests or experiences situations where local municipal roadways are closed without proper authorization for special events such as street fairs or neighborhood block parties; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare, the Borough is establishing a permitting process and standards for the closure of municipal roadways for special events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council in the Borough of Union Beach in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Street Closings for Special Events. No municipal street, roadway or right of way
Shall be closed for any special event without first receiving a permit issued by the Borough's designee. A special event may be a s street fair, block party, or any other private or public function that requires the closure of a public street under the Borough's jurisdiction.

SECTION 2. Application for Street Closing Permit. Applications for street closings for special events may be obtained from the Borough Clerk's Office, and must be filed at least three (3) full weeks prior to the scheduled event. The application form utilized may be developed and periodically amended b Borough Council in consultation with the Borough Administrator, Borough Clerk, Director of Public Works and Borough Attorney, but must minimally require the following:

- (a) names and contact information of the organizers of the special event, who shall be the responsible parties;
- (b) location of the special event with diagram or sufficient description of area of street to be closed, along with a description of the nature of the event and any equipment or amenities (chairs, tables, grills, tents, stages, bounce houses, etc.) that may be placed within the closed street;
- (c) the proposed times of the special event and time required for the street closure, including set-up and take down (no more than eight (8) hours);
- (d) a representation by the responsible parties that they have or will provide a minimum of three (3) weeks' notice to the neighbors immediately affected by the area of the street to be closed, with a copy of such notice being provided with the application.
- (e) If the special event involves any incorporated entity or vendor, a certificate of insurance must be provided naming the Borough as an additional insured in a form satisfactory to the Borough; and
- (f) All organizers of special events seeking a street closing, regardless of whether an incorporated entity or individual(s), must execute a Hold harmless Agreement included with their application.
- **SECTION 3. Application Approval.** Any application may be granted or denied at the discretion of the Borough's designee, based on any number of factors, such as, but not necessarily limited to:
 - (a) the impact that the street closure may have on access for emergency services;
 - (b) the traffic impacts the street closure may have in the area of the special event;
 - (c) significant objections from affected neighbors;
 - (d) the public resources required to ensure the safety of the event participants and drivers on municipal roadways; and/or
 - (e) failure to agree to any of the conditions imposed upon issuance of a street closing permit by the Borough, Chief of Police or their designee.
- **SECTION 4. Non-applicability.** This ordinance shall not apply to road construction addressed by other ordinances, running or bicycle races, and public marches or protests that are not stationary in nature requiring only temporary street closures.
- **SECTION 5. Violations.** Any person, corporation or other legal entity violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to penalty as stated in Chapter 3, Section 3-1 of the Code of the Borough of Union Beach.
- **SECTION 6. Repealer.** Any article, section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or other provision of the Code of the Borough of Union Beach inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 7. Severability.** If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
- **SECTION 8. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as provided for by law.

The District conducted its first of three SCBA recertification courses. This recertification is conducted annually to ensure our staff are proficient in the ability don, doff and utilize their SCBA air packs.

Additionally, Station 65-1 hosted a training lecture on street flooding response and rescue. The course was attended by a large percentage of the department membership.

Detective Bureau did 20 Fire Arm Background checks, 11 Background investigations for new employment and 5 carry conceal weapons to superior court. They also have one registration for Megan's Law.

Records Received \$85 for discovery fees, \$80 for Fire Arm Permits, They had 5 OPRA requests and there were 4 correspondences to MCPO.

Union Beach Police Department K9 Major and Sgt. Smith gave a presentation at the Library.

Union Beach Police Department also delivered a baby boy for a resident in town.

The Union Beach Police Department hosted an active shooter drill in Union Beach with all ten Bayshore area towns represented. The traffic stops are on the low side due to the restrictions from Covid but as of our conversation with the Chief, these restrictions are supposed to be lifted on New Year's Eve at midnight. As long as they do not get extended, we will be able to go back to our normal patrolling.

Mr. Robert M. Howard, Jr. Borough Administrator updates the Mayor and Council as to the status of the soccer field lighting problem. The problem will be taken care of by Quality Electric, the contractor who did the installation, weather permitting. They asked that the contractor who did the drainage work fill in the holes that were put out there as they were looking into the problem.

He also updates all that the County has awarded the contract for the replacement of Bridge R-5 which is the bridge over Florence Avenue. We have received an email today that they are setting up a preconstruction meeting during the first few weeks in January. This would be an indication that within 30-60 days construction should commence.

Mayor asks if the County will be reaching out to the Police Department. Mr. Howard states that Sgt. Taddeo is part of the email for the pre-construction meeting also Mr. Higgins will be at the meetings as this construction is directly outside of the Public Works Facility.
