RESOLUTION NO. 2015-190-: Authorizing Amending the Fee Schedule charged by Public Works for maintenance done to residential properties. (Admin. to provide)

Whereas, the Union Beach Code Enforcer and/or the Union Beach Board of Health receives complaints from time to time of unsightly and unkempt properties within the Borough of Union Beach, said violations being under the Property maintenance code, and;

Whereas, after proper notice to the owners of said properties where the violations occur, the owners fail to correct said violations within a certain time frame.

Be it Resolved, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Union Beach, that,

the Union Beach Code Enforcer and/or the Union Beach Board of Health shall notify the Director of Public Works of said violations and location of the properties, and;

Be it Further Resolved, that the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to enter upon said land for the purpose of cleaning up said properties of such violations under the property maintenance code, and notify such officials to place a lien on said properties in accordance with following fee schedule:

- Minimum charge of \$250.00 for one employee with light equipment for up to one hour.
- Each additional hour or part thereof for initial employee and light equipment \$125.00
- Additional employee for initial hour and each additional hour or part thereof \$100.00
- Use of Borough owned heavy equipment \$175.00 per hour or part thereof per piece of equipment
- Rental of heavy equipment actual cost plus \$50.00 administration fee.
