# **Proclamation** Borough of Union Beach

Whereas, radon is a naturally occurring radioactive gas that is the second leading cause of lung cancer, causing as many as 500 lung cancer deaths annually in New Jersey; and

Whereas, elevated radon levels are found in many homes and pose a serious health threat to families residing in these homes;

**Whereas**, any home may have high levels of radon – even if neighboring homes do not; and

Whereas, radon testing is easy and inexpensive - and elevated levels of radon can be effectively reduced at the cost of a typical home repair; and

**Whereas**, a significant number of homes in Monmouth County have elevated levels of radon;

**Whereas**, if all New Jersey homes with radon concentrations at or above 4 pCi/L were mitigated, about 83 lives could be saved this year.

**Now, Therefore**, I, Mayor Paul J. Smith, Jr. of the Borough of Union Beach, on behalf of the Governing Body of Union Beach, do hereby proclaim the week of January 26, 2015 as

in the Borough of Union Beach and call upon all residents who have not yet tested to test their homes for radon and to reduce radon levels if elevated levels are found, to protect their families from the serious health risk of radon.
