ORDINANCE NO.: 2020-286

MEETING OF FEBRUARY 20, 2020

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER EMOLUMENTS OF THE POLICE CHIEF AND POLICE CAPTAIN(S) OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH FOR THE FISCAL YEARS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2017 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2021

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Union Beach as follows:

SECTION 1: The following shall constitute the salaries, wages and emoluments of the indicated employees and officials of the Borough of Union Beach, payable as hereinafter provided and effective as of the adoption of this ordinance, and the publication of notice of such adoption, in accordance with the law, and continuing in effect until thereafter amended, except where otherwise specified.

The Chief and Captain(s) of the Police Department of the Borough of Union Beach covered by this ordinance shall be compensated bi-weekly pursuant to the following salary guide for the fiscal years beginning January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2021.

SECTION 2: Any benefits required to be accorded or paid to or on behalf of any employee designated herein under any employment contract and/or bargaining agreement, the execution of which was duly authorized by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Union Beach, shall be deemed authorized by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: All salaries authorized by this Ordinance shall be paid retroactively, effective to January 2, 2017, provided that the employee was still in the employ of the Borough of Union Beach at the time of the execution of the employment contract between the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Union Beach and the Chief and Captain(s) of the Police, dated December 19, 2019.

SECTION 4: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be deemed repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
