ORDINANCE NO. 2015-2**

The following Ordinance was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Board of Health of The Borough of Union Beach in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey held on Monday, November 16, 2015. It will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of said Board of Health to be held on Monday, December 14, 2015 at the Municipal Building, 650 Poole Avenue, Union Beach, New Jersey at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as said matter can be reached, at which time and place all persons who may be interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning same.

**BH - ORDINANCE NO. 2015-2**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH, 1980," ORDINANCES OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH, CHAPTER BH:1-2 DOGS, BH:1-2.1e DOG LICENSE REQUIRED.**

WHEREAS, the Union Beach Board of Health is authorized pursuant to N.J.S.A. 4:19-1 to require that all dogs that are owned by a resident, harbored or possessed within the Borough of Union Beach be licensed, and

WHEREAS, the Union Beach Board of Health has decided to set the due date for licensing, as well as the cost thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Union Beach Board of Health as follows:

BH:1-2.1e shall be amended to read:

The licenses shall be issued by the Board of Health of the Borough. The licenses, registration tags and the renewals thereof shall expire on the last day of January each year. In addition to the annual fee for license, there shall be a late charge of fifteen (\$15.00) dollars assessed against the Owner of any dog not licensed after January 31. Each and every dog shall be required to be vaccinated for protection against rabies. Evidence of such vaccination shall be presented upon applying for the license and registration tags.

In the event that the Owner of the dog(s) does not secure proper licensing before the first of March, said Owner will be issued a summons in the amount of \$75.00 for the first offense per animal. The fine will be doubled to \$150.00 second offense per animal. Continued failure to respond will result to the maximum \$300.00 per animal.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any provision, paragraph, section or subsection of this chapter be found unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this chapter shall remain in full force and effect and shall have continuing validity; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all other sections of the ordinance remain in full force and effect; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption in accordance with law.
