

Union Beach residents this update # 1 Sunday March 12th on pending winter storm heading our way. This is what we know so far. The National Weather service is predicting a blizzard like condition for Union Beach on Tuesday. The snow will start on Monday night and snow all night into Tuesday. This is a major snow event. Your Union Beach Emergency Management Team is monitoring this storm and will update you as we get it. The National Weather Service is predicting 12 to 18 inches of snow, minor coastal flooding at times of high tide. High tides for Monday will be 9:06 AM and 9:33 PM and for Tuesday High tide will be 9:47 AM and again 10:14 PM. They are also calling for strong northeast winds at 40 mph.

At this time we are asking you to please do not park in the street on Monday and Tuesday put your car in the driveway if you have one or park in your yard the ground is frozen you will have no problem. We need to give the plows as much room as possible. We cannot use Bradlees parking lot this time we are working on a new lease with them. We are asking you to stay off the roads on Tuesday so we can get the plows and emergency vehicles down the streets. If you go out you will only get stuck and block the roads. If conditions get very bad we may have to make restrictions on driving on the streets. If this happens we will let you know by Code Red. We will update you as more information comes in. Thank you for your cooperation in this event and we will get through it.
