## BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY ORDINANCE NO. 2015-227

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH APPROVING THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS EXISTING SITE (BLOCK 103, LOTS 3 AND 3.01) PURSUANT TO THE NEW JERSEY LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING LAW (N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1, ET SEQ.)

WHEREAS, the New Jersey local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq., authorizes the Borough Council of the Borough of Union Beach ("the Governing Body") to adopt by ordinance redevelopment plans for areas in need of redevelopment or rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2013, the Governing Body approved Resolution #2013-106 declaring the entire Borough as an "Area in Need of Rehabilitation"; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body authorized the preparation of a redevelopment plan for the defined as Block 103, Lots 3 and 3.01; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planner, T&M Associates, has prepared the Redevelopment Plan for the Department of Public Works Existing Site dated July 2015 (the "Redevelopment Plan"), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-7, the Governing Body referred the Redevelopment Plan to the Planning Board for review and approval following introduction and first reading; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby determines that the Redevelopment Plan is necessary and appropriate and will effectuate redevelopment and rehabilitation within the Borough.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Union Beach, in the County of Monmouth, that the Redevelopment Plan attached hereto dated July 2015, is hereby adopted; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that all prior Ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law, as the "Redevelopment Plan for the Department of Public Works Existing Site."
